

RULES FOR LADIES SECTION AT YORK CURLING CLUB

1. All league games must be played on the posted date unless changed by the games committee.
2. After the first end is complete no changes may be made in positions of players unless previously agreed with opposing skip.
3. If a game is delayed because a skip does not have enough players, she must forfeit one rock and one end for each fifteen minutes. Game is totally forfeited after one half hour.
4. A maximum of two spares may be used on a team in order not to default.
5. Each player is responsible for getting their own spare.
6. For Team Entry all spares may play any position.
7. For House League, all spares will play lead position with the exception if the skip is the person away. Vice will be given the choice to move up to skip position, should that player choose not to, then the skip's spare will play skip position. If vice moves up then the spare will play vice position.
8. An end cannot start after one hours and fifty minutes of play. For the 7:00 game, teams must be on the ice and ready to play by 7:00, therefore an end cannot start after 8:50 for the 7:00 game. Continued slow and/or late play will result in action by the games committee.
9. At least six ends must be played to constitute a game. If the game ends before eight ends, the remaining ends are to be split.
10. Scoring is as listed below:
 - 10 points for win
 - 5 points for tie
 - 1 point per end won
 - ¼ point per rock to maximum of 3 points

Defaulted game: 0 to the defaulting team, win + 4 ends + 4 rocks for opposing team (10+4+1)
11. If teams are tied at the end of a draw, the following criteria shall be applied (in order) until the tie is broken:
 - 11.1 Any team(s) which has clearly defeated the other team(s) during the draw will be declared ahead of the other team(s).
 - 11.2 The team(s) scoring more total ends in the draw will be declared ahead of the other team(s).
 - 11.3 The team(s) with the greater net difference in total rock count in the draw will be declared ahead of the other team(s).
12. For Team Entry – Competitive League
 - 12.1 Total points at the end of the final draw will determine a team's ranking at the start of next year's curling. This ranking will be used in the event of playdowns for league positions.
 - 12.2 Teams requesting entry into the Team Entry league must do so to the Ladies Games representative by March 1 of the then current season. The submitted team must consist of four current York curling club members.
 - 12.3 Should additional teams request entry into the Team Entry league, the bottom two positions will be opened for playdowns. Positions will be awarded based on round robin results. Playdowns will occur after the final draw of the season and prior to ice removal.
