Ice Allocation for 2010 – 2011

The *Curling Committee* has recently met with all of the league convenors to discuss ice allocations for next season. Everyone is excited about the prospects for the Club in a six sheet environment. One of the major challenges that we now face is how we can allocate the ice to maximize use and the resources required to maintain the ice.

In order to determine ice requirements, we need to know the numbers of participants and the number of games in a season. While we can speculate on the number of participants, the only real way to know is through a commitment by the members and prospective members. To that end, the *Board* has decided to accelerate the membership registration process to give us as much time as possible to work with the number of members and the convenors to provide the best curling experience that we can. At the same time, we are asking all league convenors to review their respective leagues and indicate what they feel their league will look like from a number of games per season point of view. When we know how many members we have participating in a league and the number of games to be played in a league, we will have the information required to allocate the ice.



We ask that you look for the membership registration package when it is sent out in June and try to get it back to Membership as soon as you can. We are looking to the first of August as the deadline for registration. We are not looking to turn anyone away from **York Curling Club** this year, however the sooner you register; the easier it will be for your league convenors to make up the leagues.
